

**Lake Chemung Riparian Association Meeting Minutes

Meeting Date: April 7, 2004

Meeting called to order at 7:30pm.

Minutes approved from March meeting.

Ginny opened meeting with discussion of monies distributed to cover bills incurred—MLSA dues, MLSA special contribution (last year of the 3 year agreed upon donation), and CLMP fees. Treasurer's Report not available—Treasurer (Sue Sytniak) had just returned from out-of-state and time did not permit preparation of a report.

Discussion of Faulkwood Shores development. Laura Wildman talked about the plans proposed at the meeting and briefly explained the proposed park option. Jack Pike talked about the best ways to delay/stop this development by everyone attending the meeting on April 26th, 2004 and discuss openly the issues/problems they see with this development. It was also indicated that Muirfield Manor individuals were developing a petition to get a park millage on the ballot.

Ginny requested volunteers to get petitions signed and said she would put together information packages for those that were interested.

Briefly discussed the possibility of getting an organized party to get someone new on the Township Board.

Weed Control – We do have the permit to go forward with the first lake survey which will be on May 24th. Jerry Matevia volunteered to ride with the survey team. The lake will be treated for miscellaneous weeds, not milfoil. A discussion on the chara growth concluded this topic.

Michigan Lakes and Streams Annual Conference – Laura Wildman indicated that she and Steve probably won't be able to attend this conference. Any one interested can let Ginny know. It was suggested that Mike Himich attend the conference depending upon his schedule.

Newsletter- The possibility of moving the newsletter to the website was discussed as well as increasing advertisers on website. This is something that we will look into further. A notice to all members will have to be sent out along

with a form that will need to be returned if a member would still like to receive the newsletters via regular mail.
